The Board President reserves the right to change the order of the items listed on the Agenda except for matters scheduled at a specific time. This agenda is subject to change up to 24 hours prior to the meeting. Board members may be present by telephone.

During the course of the meeting, the Board, upon a majority vote of a quorum of the members, may hold an executive session for the purposes of obtaining legal advice from the Board's attorney on any matter listed on the Agenda pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3), and may hold an executive session on Agenda items 4-10 for the purpose of discussion or consideration of confidential material pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2). The executive session will be held immediately after the vote and will not be open to the public.

As a reminder the resident's name is confidential, you must refer to a resident by their initials or "resident."

Items that are referenced as a Consent Agenda may be considered as a single action unless a Board Member removes a specific item for review, discussion, and action separately from the other Consent Agenda items.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02(H), the Board can discuss or take action ONLY on matters that are listed on the Agenda. Board action on issues that are not listed on the Agenda is limited to directing staff to study the matter or to schedule the matter for further discussion at a future Board Meeting.
